



The 2009 Xstrata Nickel Swim Thru Perth Terms and Conditions of Entry

I hereby declare that participation in this event is voluntary and that I will not hold Claremont Masters Swimming Club Inc or any associated organisations involved in the 2009 Xstrata Nickel Swim Thru Perth responsible for any accident, injury or death to person or loss or damage to property. I, as parent/guardian, remain responsible for my children at all times.

The organisers reserve the right to vary the course or change the event because of weather or other adverse conditions. There will be no refund of entry fees.

The event is covered for public liability under AUSSI Masters Swimming but only registered AUSSI members are covered for personal accident insurance.

Non-members should obtain their own personal accident insurance.

Entrants must be able to swim the course within 2 hours 15 min.

Team entries must have four swimmers - all swimmers complete 2.2km course.

Swimmers found displaying unsporting conduct will be disqualified.

Official event race caps must be worn at all times – no exceptions.

Wetsuits may be worn, but swimmers will not be eligible for prizes.

No paddles, fins or flotation devices may be used.

Age category awards to 4km swimmers only and to those not gaining any other prizes.

Dale Alcock OWS Series points only earned for 4km swimmers.

No watches or jewellery to be worn.

No personal paddlers to accompany swimmers.

The event is conducted according to AUSSI Masters open water swimming rules.

Late entries will only be accepted for 2.2km and 4km SOLO swimmers subject to a total field cap.

No late entries will be accepted for the team event.

Late entries are not eligible for prizes.

All competitors must travel to the respective start lines on the buses provided unless prior permission is granted by the race organisers.

All competitors must attend the compulsory race briefing at 8.45am.
